**Fine Art Conditions of Entry for 2017.**

1. All work must be the original unaided work of the exhibitor and completed within the last 12 months. (Works completed through workshops, copies or paint by numbers not accepted in any class.)
2. All work must not have been exhibited at any previous Show of this Society.
3. All work must be of a high standard. An artwork may only be entered in one class.
4. Paintings not to exceed 900mm x 900mm, including frames, due to space restrictions.
5. Entries must be properly prepared for hanging (D hooks and wire across the back about a third of the way down from the top, paper works framed and prepared likewise).
6. Each exhibit must be marked on the back with artist's name, phone number, title of artwork as per entry form, price (if for sale) and class entered.
7. Show Stewards will exercise all reasonable care with exhibits but will not be responsible for the loss or damage whatsoever to any picture or other article while in their custody.
8. Entry fee \$3.00 per exhibit, 50c per exhibit for Junior Art in sections 13 to 24(Prep to Grade 12 only). Junior artists may exhibit in classes 1 to 12 at \$3.00 per entry.
9. Entries will be received at Main Pavilion at Gatton Sports Centre between 10am and 4pm Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July.
10. Paintings may be sold at the Show. The Society will retain 12.5% commission.
11. All entries to remain on display for the duration of the Show until collection on Sunday morning.
12. Prizes to be collected with exhibits on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> July between 8am and Midday. Anything not collected by 12pm will be moved to the Show Office with no further responsibility taken.
