### Open-

#### **Champion and Reserve Champion Arrangement (Classes 1-4)**

1. **ALCOVE**- No limitations on numbers of arrangements but a minimum of two based on a theme named and suitably expressed. Alcove space provided 89 x 90 cm unrestricted height. Drapes and accessories allowed.
2. **'THREE'S'** – Fresh flower arrangement in any container only using 3 gerberas, 3 carnations, 3 roses, 3 stems of any flower of your choice and greenery.

3. **'MONOCHROMATIC'** An arrangement, any container using any flowers but of only one colour.
4. **'LONG AND LOW'** Any arrangement, any container, any flower type but has to be minimum 30cm long and no more than 10 cm high. Greenery allowed.

#### **Beginners -**

##### **Champion and Reserve Champion Arrangement (Classes 5-8)**

5. **'JUST GREENERY'** Arrangement any container but only using greenery.
6. **'ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS Arrangement'** any container using only artificial flowers.
7. **'TALL'** Arrangement using only fresh flowers and greenery but has to be a minimum of 50cm tall and 10 cm wide.
8. **'SUNSHINE'** Arrangement using any fresh flowers but only in yellow. Any container greenery allowed.

#### **JUNIOR- 12 years and under**

##### **Champion Children's exhibit (Classes 9-12)**

9. **'COFFEE MUG'** Arrangement of artificial flowers in a coffee mug.
10. **'VEGIE MONSTOR'** - Create something wild from your imagination using vegies or fruit. Don't forget to give it a name and display in on a strong piece of cardboard so it can be easily moved.
11. **'BASKET OF GREENERY'** -Arrangement using only greenery in a basket.
12. **'STICKS AND STONES'** A picture or pattern using sticks and stones etc glued to a piece of cardboard A4 size. ( PVA glue is perfect for this and cardboard can be a recycled cereal packet )
