Fine Art Conditions of Entry for 2021.

- 1. All work must be the original unaided work of the exhibitor and completed within the last 2 years (due to COVID cancelling last year's show. Normally it's 12 months.) (Works completed through workshops, copies or paint by numbers not accepted in any class.)
- 2. All work must not have been exhibited at any previous Show of this Society.
- 3. All work must be of a high standard. An artwork may only be entered in one class.
- 4. Paintings not to exceed 900mm x 900mm, or 800mm x 1000mm, including frames, due to space restrictions.
- 5. Entries must be properly prepared for hanging (D hooks and wire across the back about a third of the way down from the top, paper works framed behind glass and prepared likewise).
- 6. Each exhibit must be marked on the back with artist's name, phone number, title of artwork as per entry form, price (if for sale) and class entered.
- 7. Show Stewards will exercise all reasonable care with exhibits but will not be responsible for the loss or damage whatsoever to any picture or other article while in their custody. Insurance if desired is your responsibility.
- 8. Entry fees: \$3.00 per exhibit classes 1-12.

(Junior artists may exhibit in senior classes 1 to 12 at \$3.00 per entry if they choose.)

Framing guidelines: for the safety of your artworks, the people hanging the works and the viewing public.





Acceptable hanging:

D Rings mounted on the frame, wire or cord doubled around the hook and wrapped around neatly, ends taped or wound tightly near D Ring. No fishing line.

Eye Hooks are acceptable if INSIDE canvas edges, **not** protruding from the back.
