Important Information to be reviewed prior to submitting site request form!

- **Location:** We have three locations for sites: indoor pavilion, outdoors (around pavilion and around main ring) and Machinery/Trade space. Pavillion sites \$90 (3m x 3m), Outdoor sites \$30/m frontage, Machinery/Trade Space \$30/m frontage. You are able to request a specific frontage and depth required for your site. The Gatton Show Society will allocate your site spot at your chosen location. These locations will be based upon power, public access etc.
- **Passes:** 2 free passes per site. If frontage is 6m or greater, 1 extra pass is provided. If you require more passes these are available for \$10 per pass.
- **Powered sites:** Power to sites is \$50/ site. All leads must be tagged and tested within the last 12 months.
- **Size:** all of your site items must be within the site size boundaries.
- The Gatton Show Society will not be held responsible for loss of good or damages.
- **BUMP IN:** You will be required to come to the Show Office (under the grandstand) on Thursday 18th July between the hours of 8:00am-5:00pm. If you are unable to set up at these times, please contact us directly to organise a suitable time.
- **BUMP OUT:** All sites should be dismantled and removed between 8:00am and 12:00pm Sunday 21st July 2024. If you wish to remove your indoor pavilion site on Saturday 20th July it must be done after the Pavilion is closed to the public at 7:00pm. If you do not adhere to this your application to attend future Shows may be denied. The public who attends, pay to see all that we have on the grounds, so it is unfair to them for Site Holders to go early.
- **Show Operation hours:** Gates open to the show at 8:00am on Friday and Saturday to the public. The indoor Pavillion closes at 6:00pm Friday and 7:00pm Saturday and will be locked with onsite security present during the night. Typically, attendees of our show on the Friday are exhibitors and school groups, therefore it is not as busy compared to the Saturday. It is still expected that stall holders are ready and available for the public at these times.
- **Payment Options:** Once your site has been approved by the Show Society you will be notified via email. Please do not send payment until your request is approved and an invoice has been sent by the Show Society. Payments are due by 21st June 2024. Bookings are not guaranteed until payment is received. Sites will be reallocated without notification if bookings are not fully paid by the required date.

Workplace Health and Safety Guidelines

- All exhibitors, site holders and their employees agree to comply with the Workplace, Health and Safety Act, its regulations and all relevant codes of practice and will agree to any requests with regards to WH&S issued by the Pavilion Manager or WH&S Officer of the Gatton Show Society.

Dogs and Domestic Animals

- Under no circumstances are dogs or domestic animals permitted onto the showground during the time that the show is in operation. With the exception of assistance dogs required by exhibitors or visitors to the show.

Stock Animals

- Any stock animals used in demonstrations throughout the Show must be suitably restrained and housed. Unrestrained animals will be impounded by the Lockyer Valley Regional Council and any fines in relation to this impounding will be the responsibility of the site holder. Music

- The Gatton Show is a family Show. Please be considerate when selecting music to play on your site. The general conduct of site holders must be family friendly at all times and offensive lyrics in music as well as offensive behavior and language by site holders and their employees or representatives will not be tolerated.

Water Restrictions

- No excessive water use will be tolerated. No vehicles, equipment or machinery can be washed on the grounds.
- Water must only be used for hydration and hygiene purposes only. Ensure all connections to food outlets are sealed and do not allow water leakage. All water usage will be monitored and site holders not adhering to regulations will be asked to fix the problem immediately. Failing to fix any problems may result in having water usage restricted or dismissal from the showground. Fines may also be imposed for breach of water restrictions.

Toy Guns are acceptable; however, the following are not:

- Ball Bearing Guns
- Eight Shot Caps
- Pellet Guns
- Pop Downs (Throw Downs)
- Potato Guns
- Replica Guns (bullet type)
- Roll Caps
- Strip Caps
- Water Pistols over 150mm (6")
- Gel Blaster Guns
