### **Fine Art Conditions of Entry for 2024.**

1. All work must be the original unaided work of the exhibitor and completed within the last 12 months. (Works completed through workshops, copies or paint by numbers not accepted in any class.)
2. All work must not have been exhibited at any previous Show of this Society.
3. All work must be of a high standard. An artwork may only be entered in one class.
4. Paintings not to exceed 900mm x 900mm, or 800mm x 1000mm, including frames.
5. Entries must be properly prepared for hanging (D hooks and wire across the back about a third of the way down from the top, no string or fishing line, paper works must be framed behind glass and prepared likewise).
6. Each exhibit must be marked on the back with the artist's name, phone number, title of artwork as per entry form, price (if for sale) and class entered.
7. Show Stewards will exercise all reasonable care with exhibits but will not be responsible for the loss or damage whatsoever to any picture or other article while in their custody. Insurance, if desired, is your responsibility.
8. Entry fees: \$3.00 per exhibit classes 1-12.  
\$1.00 per exhibit for Junior Art in sections 13 to 24 (Prep to Grade 12 only).
9. Bring **Entries and payment** to Main Pavilion in Gatton Sports Centre **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July between 10am and 3.30pm.** (before Wednesday entries and forms with payment can be left at the Show Office.)
10. Paintings may be sold at the Show. The Society will retain 12.5% commission. Label 'for sale' or 'NFS' if not for sale.
11. All entries to remain on display for the duration of the Show until collection on Sunday morning.
