Grand Champion Arrangement (Classes 1 – 12)

Grand Champion Arrangement may be selected from any single arrangement.

Exhibits may only be collected between 8 am and 10 am on **Sunday 20th of July 2025** (or by prior arrangement)

OPEN - Champion and Reserve Champion Arrangement (Classes 1-4)

1. **CHRISTMAS IN JULY** - Anything goes, but must showcase Christmas, must have at least seven (7) flowers. Minimal props allowed
2. **OUT OF THE SHED** - any flowers and greenery, must include a container/props from your Shed.
3. **SO BLUE** - An arrangement, any container using any flowers but only in shades of Blue/Mauve/Purple. Greenery allowed
4. **OVER THE RAINBOW** - Any flowers - but must be in multiple colours

BEGINNERS - Champion and Reserve Champion Arrangement (Classes 5-8)

5. **'LEAVES AND STICKS' Arrangement** any container using any colour leaves and sticks.
6. **'ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS' Arrangement** any container using only artificial flowers in red tones.
7. **'MINIATURE'** - Arrangements to not be over 4 inches (10.4cm) including the container
8. **'TEA PARTY'** – any colour - greenery allowed, must be in a small to medium kettle or tea pot

JUNIOR- 12 years and under Champion and Reserve Children's Exhibit (Classes 9-12)

9. **'COFFEE MUG'** Arrangement of artificial flowers in a coffee mug.
10. **'VEGIE MONSTOR'** - Create something wild from your imagination using vegies or fruit. Don't forget to give it a name and display in on a strong piece of cardboard so it can be easily moved.
11. **'BASKET OF GREENERY'** –Arrangement using only greenery in a basket.
12. **'MY FAVOURITE TOY'** - must NOT include a Teddy Bear
